

## Golf During Covid - On Course Guidelines for Golfers

### *General rules*

- 1) Keep 2 metres apart from your playing partner at all times
- 2) Keep to group numbers permitted on the day of play. Please do not join others on the course. Golfers found playing in larger than permitted groups will be asked to leave the course.
- 3) Pace of play – vital to ensuring safe distancing is the pace of play. If you are holding up play behind, please allow golfers to play through safely and swiftly. This will avoid a hold up of groups behind your game creating unnecessary pressure on the social distancing guidelines.
- 4) Practice putting greens and driving nets are closed

### **On course rules**

- 1) All bunker rakes have been removed. Players are asked to smooth sand after their shot with their feet or club. Some bunkers on course will be marked Ground Under Repair. Remove ball from bunker and play from nearest point.
- 2) Benches should not be used and are marked as such
- 3) Flag sticks to remain in the hole and must not be touched
- 4) Hole cups have been adapted so that the ball does not fall below the surface of the putting green and can be easily retrieved by handling the ball only
- 5) No sharing of equipment, food or drinks

When your round is completed please leave the course and car park promptly.
