1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 27-1) (WHITE STAKES)

A ball is out of bounds if it lies:

Over or beyond any wall, hedge, fence or white stakes bordering the perimeters of the course.

Over and beyond any white stakes defining out of bounds within the perimeter of the course.

Over the burn to the left of the 9th green.

The car park area to the rear of the 18th green.

Beyond the burn to the right of the 6th hole.

2. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (RULE 24) (FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS)

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if a ball lies off the putting green

and not in a hazard and such an obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole the player may take relief as follows: The ball shall be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which: a) is not nearer the hole, b) avoids such intervention and c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

3. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES (IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS)

Protection of young trees is identified by blue stakes, and

individual stakes/tube protection: relief may be taken under Rule 24-2b.

4. WATER HAZARDS (RULE 26) (YELLOW STAKES)

Any burn or drainage ditch designated by yellow stakes is a Water Hazard.

5. LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (RULE 26) (RED STAKES)

Any burn or drainage ditch designated by red stakes is a Lateral Water Hazard.

6. STONES IN BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions Rule 24-1 applies.

7. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (RULE 25-1) PLAY PROHIBITED

Any area defined by blue stakes, warning tape or by white line marking (GUR).

If a player's ball lies in the area or interferes with the player's stance or the area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 25-1.

And any Temporary Local Rule Defined on the Notice Board

PENALTY FOR BREACH OF A LOCAL RULE:

Match Play – Loss of Hole;

Stroke Play – Two Strokes.
