Local Rules (AMENDED 12 MARCH 2004)

1. OUT OF BOUNDS (RULE 27) (WHITE STAKES)

A ball is out of bounds if it lies:

Over or beyond any wall or fence bordering the perimeters of the course.

Over and beyond any white stakes defining out of bounds within the perimeter of the course. Out of bounds markers between 18th and 1st fairways are only applicable when playing the 18th hole. A ball finishing right of the markers up to the last marker short of the 18th green is deemed out of bounds.

2. IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS (RULE 24) (FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS)

All fixed sprinkler heads are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 24-2. In addition, if a ball lies off the putting green and not in a hazard and such an obstruction on or within two club-lengths of the putting green and within two club-lengths of the ball intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole the player may take relief as follows: The ball shall be lifted and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which: a) is not nearer the hole, b) avoids such intervention and c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

3. PROTECTION OF YOUNG TREES (IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS)

Protection of young trees is identified by blue stakes, or

individual stakes/tube protection: relief may be taken under Rule 24-2b.

4. WATER HAZARDS (RULE 26) (YELLOW STAKES)

Any burn or drainage ditch designated by yellow stakes.

5. LATERAL WATER HAZARDS (RULE 26) (RED STAKES)

Any burn or drainage ditch designated by red stakes.

6. STONES IN BUNKERS

Stones in bunkers are movable obstructions Rule 24-1 applies.

7. GROUND UNDER REPAIR (RULE 25-1) PLAY PROHIBITED

Any fixed area defined by blue stakes, warning tape or by white line marking (GUR).

If a player's ball lies in the area or interferes with the player's stance or the area of intended swing, the player must take relief under Rule 25-1.

And any Temporary Local Rule Defined on the Notice Board

Match Play – Loss of Hole;

Stroke Play – Two Strokes.
